Our November Meeting

Our next Historical Society meeting will be held on Wednesday, November 9, at 7:00 pm in the Auditorium (Multipurpose Room) of the Milpitas Library, 160 North Main Street. At this meeting, our distinguished speaker, Santa Clara County Judge Paul Bernal, will talk about the Roberto Adobe, built in 1836, and the adjoining Sunol House, begun in 1854.

These two structures, located in what is now Willow Glen, are part of the newly opened Roberto Adobe Sunol House Museum, owned and operated by the California Pioneers of Santa Clara County. These venerable structures are among the oldest in this area; their history, the story of their rescue from near-

destruction, and their preservation due to the hard work of Paul and many others of the Pioneers will be the topic of this presentation.

Bob McGuire Park Opening

The opening of the park dedicated to the memory of Milpitas' first Parks and Recreation Director (1964-80), Bob McGuire, was held on Saturday, October 1. Bob McGuire was one of the founding members of the Milpitas Historical Society, and a past President and Vice President.

The 3-acre park named in his honor is part of a developing residential area north of South Milpitas Blvd. and Montague Expwy. It features tennis courts, an outdoor amphitheater, and a community center building dedicated to longtime community leader Sal Cracolice. The opening was attended by family members of both honorees and many community leaders.
